The library is comprising more than four thousand printed medical books along with ten international, 5 local journals, three magazines, two local newspapers costing more than 10 million over and above the electronic resources, HEC digital library access and two thousand video lectures on various medical subject for its Bonafede users (i.e. Faculty and students of RMDC). In addition to above well-established electronic which is maintaining YouTube Channel as well.

LIBRARY SERVICES FOR RMDC FACULTY AND STUDENTS

1. RMDC Learning Resource Center is providing essential library services to the students, faculty and researchers. The library provides access electronic/ databases for health related information. Details for services being provided are as under:

Research Support

2. Learning Resource Center is also providing assistance services such as Literature search, citation management, and research assistance and guidance to the Library users.

3. Three thousand electronic books on medical subjects and electronic journal resources related to medical education, research are also made accessible from electronic resources.

Interlibrary loan (ILL):

4. Interlibrary loan services for journals' articles and electronic books are also available for the RMDC faculty and students.

Information Literacy Programs:

5. RMDC Learning Resources center is also arranging training sessions for the users to train how to search, evaluate and utilize medical information effectively.

Reference and Consultation Services:

6. RMDC Library staff is available to provide searching assistance in making Research related assignments or searching specific resources.

Book lending Services

7. All students and faculty are entitled to borrow books and other materials according to the RMDC Library rules and regulations. Please inquire at the Circulation Desk for your eligibility. However ID card of the user is required for borrowing of books at the Circulation Desk.

Archives Special Collection

8. Learning Resource Center had substantial collection of medical archives material of books and research thesis and General books.

9. The RMDC learning Resource Center further working to provide access to digital services from off campus locations for students and faculty as well. The Electronic books data is uploaded on Rahbar (LMS) Learning Management System will be accessible for off campus timings.
